

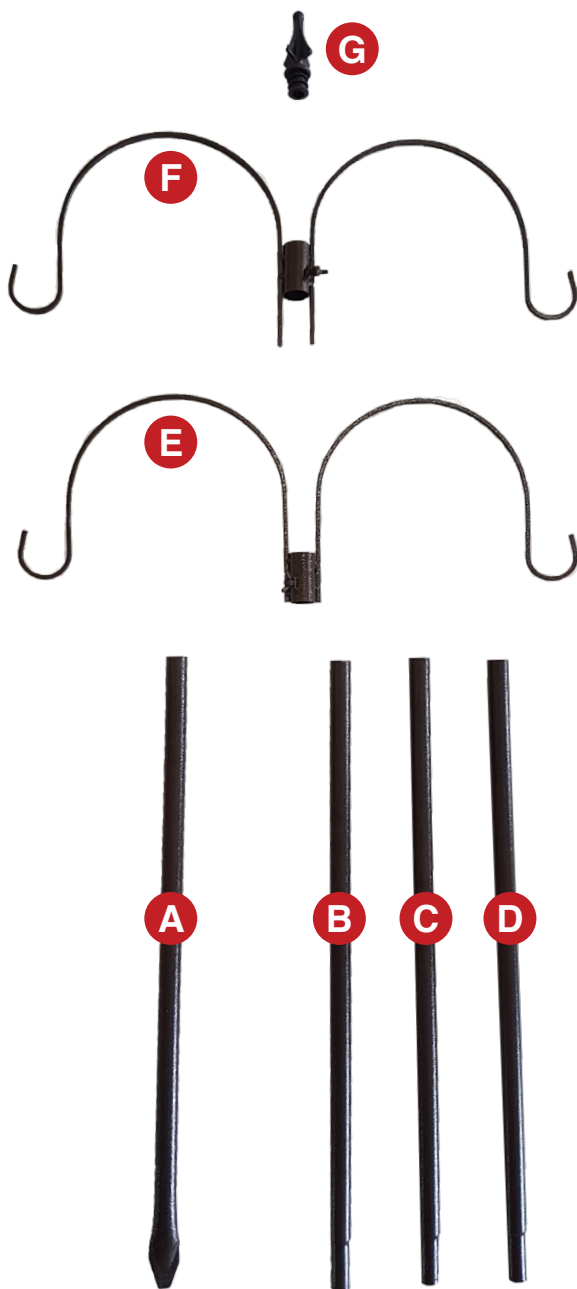

## Deluxe

### Bird Feeding Station

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



Knock the spiked Pole (A) into the ground where you plan on placing your feeding station. Be sure to use a rubber mallet or something similarly soft to hammer the pole into the ground to avoid damaging the mouth of the pole. Hammer the pole as deep as you can to ensure maximum stability.

Insert Pole B into Pole A, C into B and D into C. You can exclude Pole D from assembly if you'd prefer the feeding station to stand shorter. (Poles B, C and D are identical). No fixing or securing required.

Slide Arms (E) on to the top pole, leaving approximately 10cm of the top pole above the arm sleeve. Tighten the wingnut so that it is secure and cannot slide.

Slide Arms (F) on to the top pole so that it sits flush against the sleeve of Arms (E). Tighten the wingnut so that it is secure and cannot slide. Ensure that Arms E and Arms F extend perpendicular to each other.

Push the Spire (G) into the opening of the top Pole D.

Hang your feeders on the arms.

#### Tips :

Ideally, locate the feeding station away from any cover that could be used by pests or predators to ambush or interfere.

Moving the feeding station to a different area of the garden each month will help to prevent the build-up of droppings, which could become a health risk to birds and other garden wildlife.

Clean your station and any feeders regularly to avoid the build-up of harmful bacteria.
